Summary of Duties: The slitter operator is responsible for the best utilization of the film allocated to the set up to complete the set up. The slitter operator must work in an efficient manner to achieve the highest level of production, while maintaining a high level of quality. Proper production reporting is essential.

Daily Functions:

- 1. Retrieve top set up on the schedule
- 2. Verify set up
- 3. Verify film to the set up and the correct master roll.
- 4. Give packer necessary documentation needed to have labels made.
- 5. Make sure proper size cores are placed correctly on the rewind shafts.
- 6. Make sure counter is set to the proper footage
- 7. Adjust machine accordingly.
- 8. Fill out necessary paperwork for packers and supervisors.

Other Responsibility:

- 1. Must maintain a clean and safe work environment.
- 2. Report all machine problems to supervisor or lead.
- 3. Must keep accurate productions reporting.
- 4. Other duties required by management.
